Proposals for participation in the B&J session should be submitted to the STE submission server ([ConfTool@ Submission Server](#)) to the respective Special Session track. The submissions should follow the structured abstract template (see "For authors" section) but with the following sections: Title of the publication, authors/editors/publishers, context, content of the publication, highlights, conclusions/summary/recommendations, and references (optional), in total 1-2 pages.

Submissions will be reviewed by at least two members of the Special Session's Program Committee, and acceptance decisions will be made by the conference program Co-Chairs and Special Sessions Chair.

The presentations will be organized and held by the submitting authors, editors, or publishers.
