

	2 From Mo Chit Station		
	1 Board the BTS Sukhumvit Line at Mo Chit Station (light green line) heading towards Kheha .		
	2 Ride for 6 stops and get off at Phaya Thai Station .		
	3 Exit via Exit 4 .		
	4 Walk for about 3–5 minutes (approx. 300 meters) down Sri Ayutthaya Road to reach The Sukosol Hotel (https://maps.app.goo.gl/uVVMQXVkcDbDjKxzq6).		
	5 Time: Approx. 24 minutes total.		
	6 Cost: ฿40.		
	3 By Bus		
	Taking the bus to The Sukosol Hotel is the cheapest option, though it often takes longer due to Bangkok's traffic. The hotel is located on Sri Ayutthaya Road, near major bus stops like Victory Monument and Ratchathewi District Office.		
	1 From Siam/MBK: Take Bus 29, 34, 36, or 54 from MBK Center or Siam Square towards Victory Monument. Alight at the Ratchathewi District Office or Wannasorn Building.		
	2 Cost: ฿8–฿25 depending on if the bus has air-con.		
	3 Time: 10–15 minutes (without traffic).		
	4 Payment: Most orange (air-con) and blue/pink (new electric) buses accept Contactless Credit Cards or the Rabbit Card. Small orange and red buses are cash only (usually ฿8–฿10).		
	5 Bus Stops: Look for the blue bus sign or a shelter. In Thai, the hotel area is often referred to as "Phaya Thai" or "Si Ayutthaya."
